Scholarship and Awarding Policy

International School of Bucharest offers a scholarship each academic year. Scholarships are awarded for students from secondary school, on the basis of academic ability, as recognition of the extraordinary performance in the exams.

Conditions for scholarship based on Cambridge Results:

- *The reward is given only to the students remaining in the school for the next academic year*
- *Only the results from May/June Session are considered*
- *Qualifications involved are IGCSE and AS Level, no awards given for A2 Level*
- *The scholarship is awarded only for Cambridge International Examination, other examinations are not considered (such as OCR or Edexcel)*
- *Each A* obtained in the IGCSE qualification is rewarded with 200 RON*
- *Each A^ obtained in the AS qualification is rewarded with 400 RON*

International School of Bucharest reserves the right to adjust the scholarship award every year, according to budget.

Conditions for awards based on academic results and exceptional behavior:

- *Students with high academic success, achievements in national and international competitions, top Educare points, and exceptional behavior may be awarded with national and international field trips, university visits, summer school and science camp by the approval of the Senior Management Team (SMT).*
- *If a student is granted an award to external trip, depending on the annual budget allocated, all the expenses of the students are covered by school.*
